

Survey: Brits Ready to Make Personal Sacrifices for Their Pet

People in Britain have been known for the level of love they shower upon their pets, and a new study has been able to highlight this fact since a lot of pet owners would be ready to make personal sacrifices to make sure that their pet remains healthy and fit.

Without doubt, the poll carried out by Tesco Bank made this finding that around half or 46% of such a group have insured their pets, whilst just 36% have health insurance coverage for their own self.

Given at any point their dog or cat needs medical help, 47% of respondents stated that they would cut down on their spending related to eating out, without giving a thought and another 29% would not mind cancelling their summer vacation trip.

Over one in five or 21% would go ahead at canceling their gym membership, so as to assure that the best could be afforded by them for their pets.

Another 7% would get their pets insured but not themselves.

Veterinarian Dr. Scott Miller said that this was because a lot of people did not consider their pets as pets but family members.
